# Charges for sports facilities: Scotland 2016/17

Putting sport first



#### This information digest:

- describes the approach to the review, undertaken annually since 1985;
- summarises the 2016/17 charges;
- reports on the trends in sports facilities/activities charges over the period 2012 to 2016; and
- presents the results of a survey of concessionary and passport access schemes in Scotland.

#### **Background**

This annual research undertaken by **sport**scotland provides an overview of public sector charges for the use of indoor and outdoor sports facilities and swimming pools. It is based on a survey of the Scottish local authorities and their associated leisure trusts, covering over 70 different activities or facilities.

#### Changes in this year's report

After each of the last seventeen charges surveys, short user feedback surveys were undertaken to determine the need for and scope of any future developments. The feedback from these identified some areas for refinement, but indicated that the charges review largely satisfied existing requirements.

#### The 2016/17 charges review

The data shows the cost of participation in indoor, outdoor and swimming activities as detailed in Appendices I-V. Charges show the minimum, maximum and average charge for each activity or facility, giving the full range of charges reported and the sample size of the number of local authorities or associated leisure trusts which operate a charge for a particular type of activity or facility. The maximum sample size possible in each area of activity is 32; this year there were responses from all 32 local authority areas.

An average of the different prevailing rates within each local authority area has been used to represent its charges. This should ensure the validity of the overall arithmetic means generated, but may influence the recorded maximum or minimum for a particular charge category.

#### Benchmark charges

To simplify the tables and text, the calendar year in which the charges commence is used to identify that year. As a result, charges set for the financial year 1 April 2016 to 31 March 2017 are identified as 2016 figures.

Table 1 shows the charges in 2016 for the most popular sports activities and facilities in Scotland, covering adult, juvenile and senior citizen customers, with the corresponding 2015 charges provided for comparison.

#### **Observations**

Eleven of the 19 charge categories in Table 1 show a percentage increase in arithmetic mean above the prevailing growth in the Retail Price Index (RPI) which was 2% over the same period. Of the remainder, four increased below that rate while four decreased.

The largest percentage increases were in table tennis charges, where price per table, per hour rose from £5.50 to £5.96 for adults and from £3.48 to £3.75 for juveniles. For adult table tennis charges 14 out of 24 local authorities had increased charges, while none had reduced their charges. For juvenile charges there is a similar pattern as 11 out of 24 local authorities increased charges and one local authority reduced their charge.

The peak charge for a round of golf for senior citizens rose by 4.8%, an increase of 68p. However, the same charge for adults and juniors rose by only 0.45% and 2.44%

respectively. One local authority stated that they had specifically reduced the concession for senior citizen golf charges to bring them in line with other authorities/Trusts' charges.

The price of swimming lessons increased on average by 4.17% for juveniles and 3.9% for adults, although these rises were relatively small in terms of pounds and pence: 17p and 22p, respectively.

The biggest decrease was seen in squash charges (which had been the area of highest increase in last year's review) where the mean charge for junior squash court hire fell by 1.99%. It is important to note however that only 3 of 25 local authorities reduced their junior squash court hire prices, while 9 held prices constant and 13 increased their charges.

In the last few years membership schemes have become more prevalent for public facilities and activities. Table 2 shows the range of charges for these schemes, along with the change in average charge for individuals. This is split by type of access for both annual memberships and direct debit monthly payment schemes across local authority areas. More detailed information is available in Appendix IV.

Table 2 shows a slight increase of 1.5% in the average monthly charge for combined access to *gym, swim, health suite and fitness classes*. At the same time, the average annual membership for the same facilities decreased by 2.5%. This reduction was primarily driven by one local authority, who introduced a new membership scheme with a 28% reduction in cost. This was the only authority to reduce its charge. Nine authorities held the cost of their

annual *gym, swim, health suite and fitness* memberships constant, eight increased charges, and three reported this charge for the first time.

The average annual cost for *gym*, *swim* and *fitness* class memberships also decreased further than the average monthly charge for the same facilities.

It is important to acknowledge that membership schemes have become more important to local authority facilities as they offer a guaranteed income; this is likely to continue in future years.

#### Trends in sports facilities charges: Scotland 2012 to 2016

This section presents a summary of the movement in charges between 2012 and 2016 for a selected sample of the ten most popular sporting activities and facilities in Scotland. Charges are outlined for various categories of customer and reference is made to the corresponding change in the Retail Price Index.

Four tables are detailed in the following pages, showing actual charges (Table 3) as well as year-on-year variations with respect to absolute and percentage price changes (Tables 4 and 5), and price changes adjusted for inflation (Table 6). The RPI percentage increase quoted is the figure to September in the year concerned, reflecting the midpoint of each charging period.

It should be noted that most charges started at a fairly modest base level and that rises in RPI have remained low - around 2% in the last year. This means that large percentage increases in charges can equate to fairly insignificant rises in the cash price of participation for the activities and facilities sampled.

For example, the percentage price increase for adult swimming lessons between 2012 and 2016 was 18.7%, the highest in that time period. In cash terms this equates to a total rise of £0.92 for the four years or an increase of £0.23 a year. If the effect of the upward movement (8.5%) in the RPI is taken into account, the average annual increase in real terms is a modest £0.12.

When team sports are involved and the cost of an activity can be shared amongst several participants, price increases per individual are even less significant. For example, between 2012 and 2016 average prices for adult indoor five-a-side football rose by 4.9%, equivalent to £1.85. On the assumption that ten juveniles are involved per game, the effective annual price rise for each individual is an average of £0.05 (5 pence).

Looking at changes on a year by year basis, adjusted for inflation, some activities and facilities have seen a consistent reduction in real terms. For example golf charges for adults and squash charges for both adults and juveniles have decreased in real terms in three of the last four years. In comparison, swimming activities have increased above the prevailing rate of inflation in each year.

Of the 19 activities considered, 9 (47%) saw charges decrease in real terms over the 2012 to 2016 period, while the remaining 10 saw charges increase.

Looking at the overall picture between 2012 and 2016, aggregate charges for the selected sports facilities and activities increased above the prevailing rate of inflation as measured by the Retail Price Index, increasing on average by 2.4% compared to an overall average increase in retail prices of 2.2%. Price increases have therefore been slightly higher in comparison to increases in the general cost of living over the past four years.

# Concessionary charging and passport access schemes in Scotland

A questionnaire relating to concessionary charging schemes was introduced to the 1995 Charges Review and has been repeated each year since. This year, results are based on responses from 30 local authorities.

Information is collected on the three main types of scheme:

- concession charges;
- · concession card scheme; and
- passport card scheme.

Concessionary schemes and charging have been in place across Scotland's local authorities for a number of years; over two thirds of respondents stated these schemes had been in place for more than ten years.

#### **Concession charges**

This scheme is directed at individuals from financially or socially disadvantaged groups and involves the application of reduced charges for, or the free use of, various activities and facilities. Of the 30 responding local authority areas, 23 (77%) offer this type of scheme.

#### **Concession card scheme**

This scheme involves the provision of a concession card solely to individuals from financially or socially disadvantaged groups, where use of the card affords access to a range of activities and facilities for reduced or no charge. It is offered in 8 (27%) of the responding local authority areas.

#### Passport access scheme

This scheme makes concession cards, for which a charge is levied, available to general users. It is offered by 11 (37%) of the Charges Review respondents.

Table 7 details the different types of user groups that are eligible to use at least one of the three main categories of concessionary charging schemes available in the 30 responding local authority areas:

Concessionary charging schemes are made available in some form to customers from other local authority areas by 11 (37%) of the respondents. Thirty five percent of concession charges schemes are open to non-residents. Passport Access Schemes are made available to non-residents by 45% of the respondents who operate such schemes. This year, none of the authorities who operated concession card schemes reported making those available to non-residents.

The range of facilities offered under concessionary charging schemes is shown in Table 9, below:

Of the 16 respondents that operate the main card based concessions, 13 (81%) do not offer any associated benefits of scheme participation in addition to discounted or free admission. The remaining three authorities all offer both advanced and telephone booking privileges.

Local authorities and leisure trusts also offer concessionary schemes for particular activities, including free swimming. Twelve out of 30 local authorities offer free swimming for school age children in the school holidays, while two authorities offer free swimming year round to all school age children and four authorities offer free swimming to those aged over 60.

#### Comparisons with 2015

In general the landscape for concessionary charging this year is not significantly different from last year.

This year has seen the numbers of local authorities offering concession charges, concession card schemes and passport access schemes reduce by one, two and two respectively.

There has also been a reduction in the proportion of authorities who make their concessionary schemes available to those resident outwith their own area.

However, in other cases concession schemes have been extended to include new users, such as those in receipt of Carer's Allowance, and Personal Independence Payment.

2016 year has also seen an increase in the number of Local Authorities offering free swimming to children during school holidays, as well as the number offering free swimming to children year-round.

#### **Future developments**

The 2016 Charges Digest is the 30th edition in a series that has been subject to various developments over the years aimed at improving the quality and relevance of its content, as well as the clarity of its presentation. In the coming year, we will issue a short user survey to determine the need for and shape of future surveys.
